Listed fees comprise of reproduction fees and use fees. For use type and category definitions, please scroll to the bottom of this document.

Explanation of use categories:

Personal: Images cannot be used for any form of monetary gain (donation or otherwise) and cannot be published in any form. Images are limited to 300 dpi resolution.

Research scans: Reproductions of archival and in print bibliographic material for research use only. Scans cannot be redistributed, shared or published in any form.

Educational: Images for not for profit, educational use only. Can be used for classroom presentations, coursework research, and published for scholarly presentations and dissertations. Images are limited to 300 dpi resolution.

Non-profit Organizations/Reproduction in scholarly periodicals 501(c)(3)organizations. Images can be used for publishing in scholarly research publications (when projects are connected to a university press).

Commercial Organizations: Categorized as any for profit entity.

Brooklyn Based Entities: Brooklyn based organizations, individuals, artists, companies, educational centers etc.
