

Use this map to guide your walk in the neighborhood while listening to the Places We Gather audio tour. The guided walk begins at the Walt Whitman Library, passes through Fort Greene Park, and ends at Commodore Barry Park. During the walk, you'll hear residents share anecdotes about important gathering places, changes in the neighborhood, stories of mutual aid initiatives, and memories of individuals coming together to support one another. The guided walk takes an estimated 1-1.5 hours to complete.

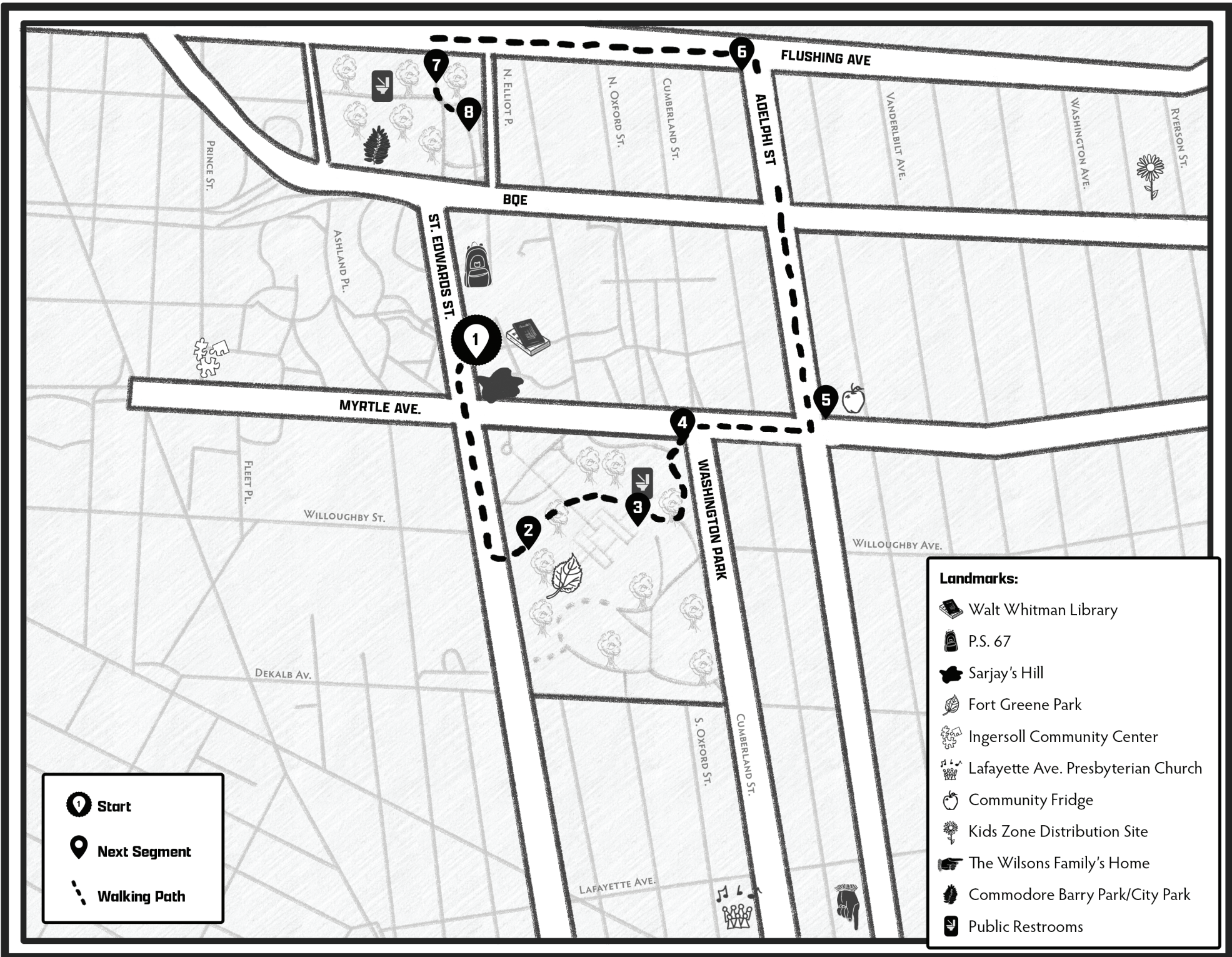
